ASTARTA ranked the third in the National Philanthropists rating



On July 5, 2013 the Supervisory Board of the National Philanthropists rating, composed of PriceWaterhouseCoopers (PwC Ukraine) and Baker & McKenzie representatives as well as Ukrainian sociologist, director of "Democratic Initiatives" foundation Irina Bekeshkina, named the winners for the year 2012 in three categories: company-philanthropist, charitable foundation or organization-philanthropist, individual-philanthropist. The evaluation was based on documented financial figures spent on charity. ASTARTA ranked the third among corporate bodies and became the only agri-industrial company in the rating.

The rating which is a joint initiative of community-based organization "Socially responsible society" and Ukrainian Philanthropists Forum in partnership with the magazine «Hallmarker» was attended by 59 organizations, companies and individuals.

As of the beginning of August ASTARTA harvested early grains on the area of 52 thousand ha (91% of the total land under early grains). The average yields are 31% higher than in previous year.

Pakistan wheat imports could reach one million tonnes this year



Pakistan is set to become a net wheat importer this

year with purchases climbing to the highest in five years after delayed planting and reduced fertiliser use hit domestic output and drove up local prices. The South Asian nation, which has been exporting wheat for the last three years, joins a growing list of countries that have seen production curbed, squeezing global supplies and buoying prices.

Pakistan is likely to ship in 800,000 tonnes to 1 million tonnes of wheat in the year to March 2014, traders said, the most since 2008/09 and way up from the 200,000 tonnes bought last year. Supply will mainly come from the Black Sea region due to competitive prices offered there. "We are have just finished the harvest and one would imagine that everything is alright but prices are moving higher," said a Karachi-based grains trader.

"There is shortfall in the market as our production was well below the government's target and there has been drawdown in stocks." Wheat production in Pakistan slid to 23.3 million tonnes in 2012/13, the lowest in four years and down from 25 million tonnes a year ago, according to the US Department of Agriculture. Output in 2013/14 is estimated at 24 million tonnes.

Brazil analyst sees 65 million tonnes sugar cane hurt by frost



The frost in southern Brazil damaged 18 percent of the remaining 365 million tonnes of sugar cane still unharvested of the 2013/14 center-south crop, sugar and ethanol analyst Datagro said. Datagro President Plinio Nastari told Reuters that severe frost on July 24 and 25 in some southern cane growing regions in the world's largest exporter of sugar may have killed entire fields, which would likely require replanting. "We don't know how much of the affected 65 million tonnes of cane has been lost yet. We should know in about a week," Nastari said by phone. "We still need to test how deeply the frost impacted the

cane. A field is not always uniformly affected." Nastari said some fields will need to be replanted and some will rot before mills get a chance to harvest them. He said frost killed the inner core, or gem, of cane plants in some areas.

Prysiazhniuk names grain forecast of over 57 million tons



Ukraine is planning to harvest more than 57 million tons of grain this season, almost half of which will be corn.

Agricultural Policy and Food Minister Mykola Prysiazhniuk said this at a briefing at the Cabinet of Ministers on Thursday, the press service of the Agri-

cultural Policy and Food Ministry reported.

"I would also like to name a grain harvest forecast. This year Ukraine plans to collect more than 57 million tons of grain. A large part of it will be corn - more than 28 million tons. This is currently the most export-oriented crop," Prysiazhniuk said.

He said that the pace of the current harvesting campaign is significantly higher compared to previous years. Ukrainian farmers have currently harvested 28 million tons of grain from 90% of the area under winter crops. Ukraine's southern regions completed the collection of early crops. The average yield of grain crops in Ukraine is 29.8 quintals per hectare, or 5 quintals per hectare more than last year.

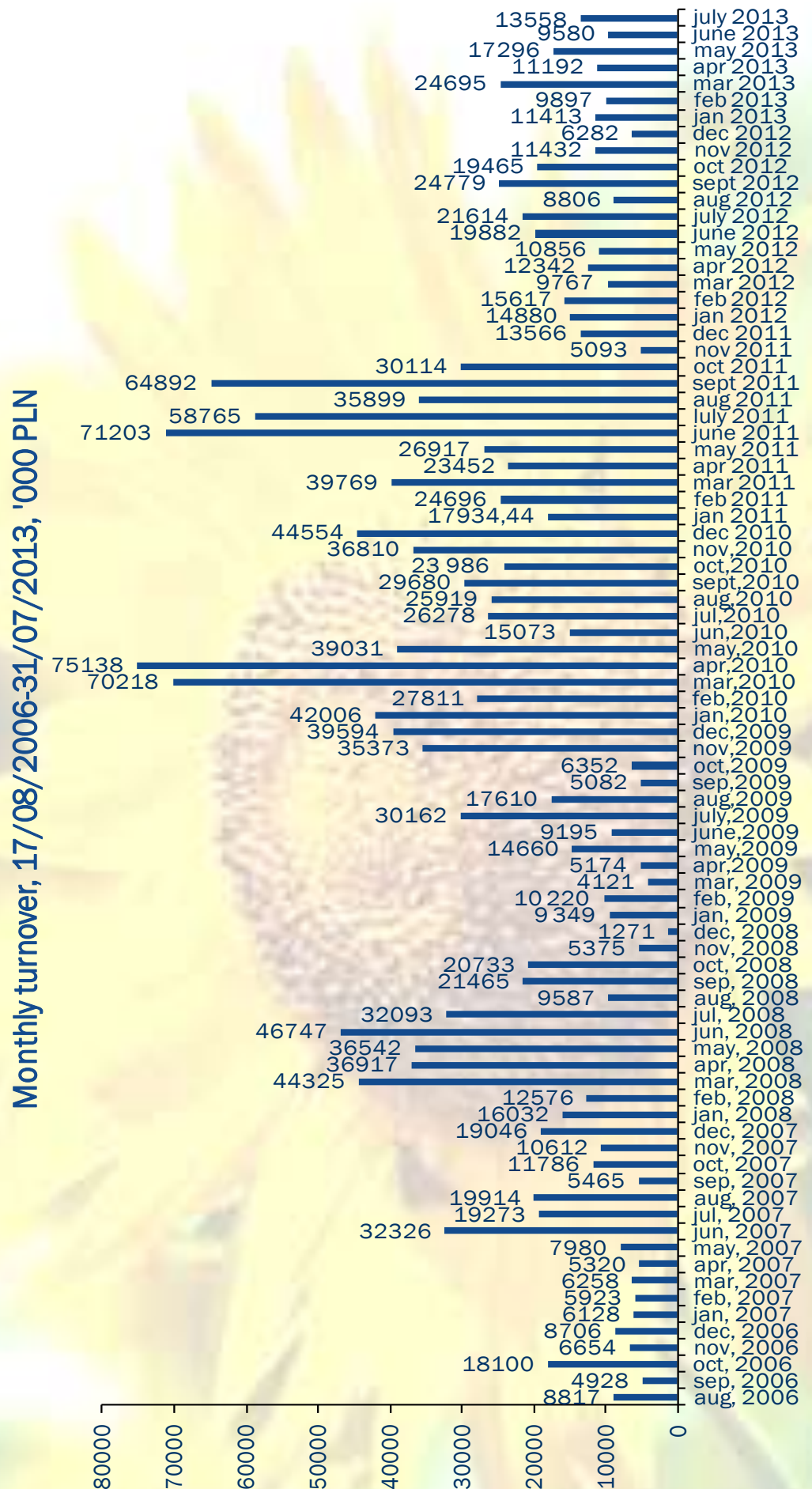
