Coal stocks at power plants

No anthracite is supplied to Ukrainian TPPs since February, 11th. Full railway blockade of coal supplies from the NCT continues. The emergency state introduced in the energy sector by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine on February 15th allowed to keep strict control over depletion of coal stocks at TPPs.

SCM Group has always been working only within the laws of Ukraine, including our businesses in the NGCA. No pressure can make us change the jurisdiction of our assets.

We provide jobs to hundreds of thousands of people across the country, from the west to the east, including in the NGCA. We supply heating, electricity and gas to millions of Ukrainian households.

SCM is one of few links between the government controlled areas and non-government controlled areas of Ukraine.

Despite the challenging political situation in the country and the ongoing hostilities, all SCM Group companies pay taxes and duties in full to the Ukrainian budget.

Since the conflict in Donbas broke out, SCM Group has paid over UAH 100 billion in taxes to the national budget, of which 10% are attributable to the businesses in the NGCA.

We believe that private property is sovereign, and the demands of re-registration of our companies and payment of taxes to self-proclaimed DNR and LNR are unacceptable.
